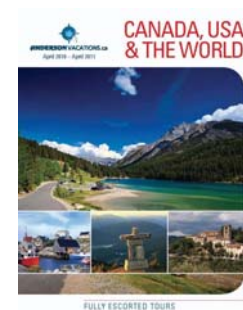

Ottawa

This year marks the 65th anniversary of the liberation of the Netherlands, in which Canadian soldiers played such a large role. Afterward, the Dutch Royal Family sent a gift of 100,000 tulip bulbs to the people of Canada, via Ottawa, in a gesture of respect and friendship and those tulips form the basis of what evolved into the [Canadian Tulip Festival](#) and in fact, a tulip gift continues to be made each year!

This year, the Canadian Tulip Festival will run May 7 - 24, and will honour veterans by hosting many special events, including an opening day afternoon tribute at the National War Memorial. The 300,000 tulips at Commissioners Park near Dows Lake are always the focus, and, as of May 14, activities begin in Major's Hill Park as well. Tour the world at the International Pavilion, grab a brew at the Liberation Beer Garden, and catch an event at Celebridée (the "festival of ideas").

Royal fun on [Canada Day](#). Canada Day, July 1, is the biggest party day of the year in Ottawa. This year, Queen Elizabeth and Prince Philip have decided to join in the fun. No word yet as to whether they'll be watching the Changing the Guard Ceremony or Royal Canadian Mounted Police Musical Ride performance on Parliament Hill, or staying up till 10:15 pm for the huge fireworks display that caps off the celebration.

NGC Welcoming Pop Life. From June 11 to September 19, 2010, the [National Gallery of Canada](#) will be home to the controversial exhibit Pop Life: Art in a Material World featuring works by Andy Warhol, Jeff Koons, Keith Haring and many more. It has been shown at the Tate Modern in London, and Ottawa will be the only North American stop on the tour.

When it first opened in June 1989, the IMAX Theatre at the [Canadian Museum of Civilization](#) was the first theatre in the world to combine the IMAX screen and the IMAX Dome in the same room. Now, visitors can enjoy IMAX 3D technology, a new state-of-the-art sound system, a new screen and new seats. Thanks to all of these

improved features, the IMAX Theatre will be the only one in North America to present 3D films on the IMAX screen and 2D films on the Dome.

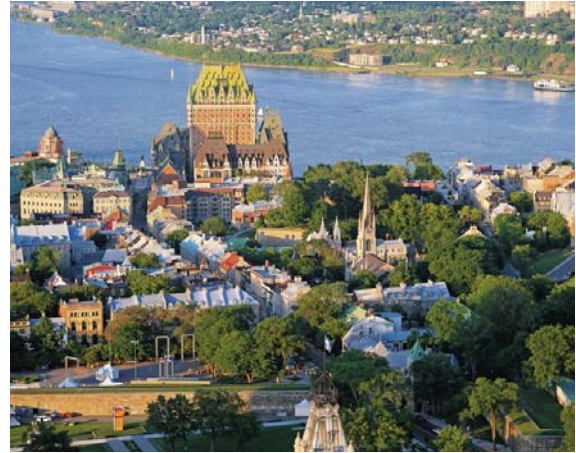

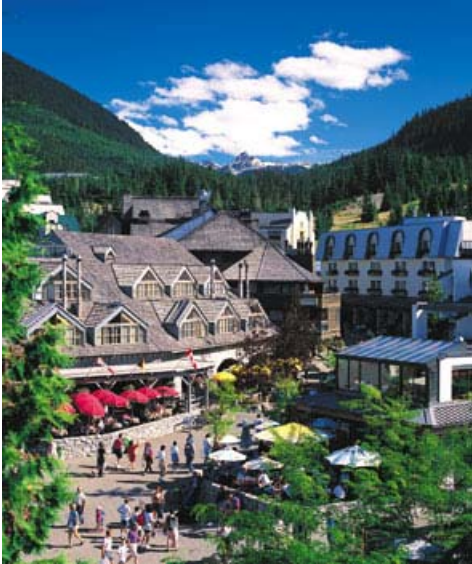
